Right to Information (RTI) Act, 2005

The Honourable President of India gave his consent to the Right to Information Act, 2005 on 15.06.2005 and the same has come into existence with effect from 12.10.2005.

The Right to Information Act, 2005 sets out the practical regime of Right to Information for citizens to enable them to access the information under the control of public authority in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of such authority.

As per the Act, "Information" means any material in any form, including records, documents, memos, e-mails, opinions, advices, press releases, circulars, orders, logbooks, contracts, reports, samples, models, data material held in any electronic form and information relating to any private body which can be accessed by a public authority under any other law for the time being in force.

As per the provisions of the Right to Information Act, 2005 a citizen can seek for the information in relation to a public authority which is established, constituted, owned, controlled or substantially financed by funds provided directly or indirectly by the State Government by an application to the Public Information Officer. The Right to Information is a right conferred on the citizens of India only.

Section 2(h) of the Act defines "Public authority" as any authority or body or institution of self-governance established or constituted by or under the constitution or by law made by the Parliament or any state legislature or by notification issued by the appropriate Government. It includes body owned, controlled or substantially financed by the government.

In accordance with the provisions contained in Section 2(j) of the Act, Right to Information means right to information accessible under this Act which is held by or under control of a public authority.
